Security tips for your home

There have recently been burglaries in your area.
Prevent yourself from becoming the next victim.

Get the lived-in look

When you go out make your home look lived-in

- 1 Leave a radio or television on, or side table lamps when it is dark, so that while you are out any potential burglar will hear a noise or see a light and be deterred. Use a timer switch to set and control times if necessary.



Secure your valuables

- 1 A safe securely fixed to a solid wall and/or floor reduces the likelihood of important documents, valuables and sentimental items being stolen.
- 2 Property marking and photographing valuables and sentimental items will help to deter burglars and assist police to return them to their rightful owners if they are stolen.
