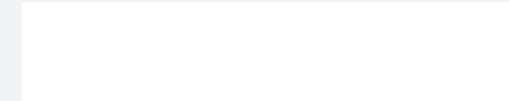
# Our commitment to British Deaf Association's BSL Charter

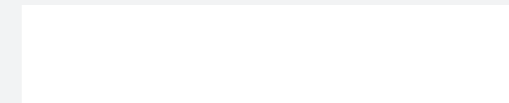
## We are committed to five pledges that will:

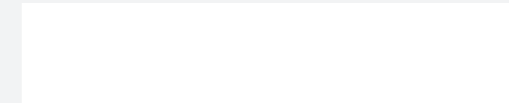

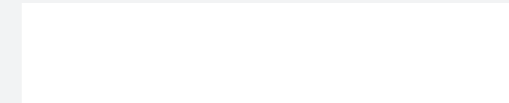
